




The above Facebook page bio for Christopher Reeves:

He was born in New York - Christopher Reeves on Sept. 25, 1952, from parents Barbara Johnson and Franklin D. Reeves. His sibling is Benjamin Reeves. During his childhood days his friends nicknamed him Chris or Toph. He stood 6'4". He was married to Dana, and had a child with her - Will Reeves. He had two children before Will, and they are Matthew and Alexandra Reeves. He went to Cornell University and Juilliard School of Performing Arts where he shared a room with Robin Williams - a good and dear friend. I was a licensed pilot much like John Travolta. He is better associated with his character role as SUPERMAN and CLARK KENT. He and Jane Seymour made a classic movie together. They became best friends. He suffered body paralysis due to a horseback riding accident. He died on October 10, 2004 from a heart attack. He is survived by his children.
