

How to stop gun violence in schools

Everyone needs to pay attention for the telltale signs of violence. Remove any weapons from your home. If students do not have access to weapons, then they are less likely to use them in school. Just be a good role model. Report any threats or suspicious behavior. Sure they can build a fortress-like school with higher fences, taller block walls, limit access to one gate, close the campus, install magnetometers and x-ray machines, and conduct pat downs and routine locker searches. And they can add armed guards and police officers, add state-of-the-art video surveillance, and limit sport field activities. What causes gun violence in schools?

Shooters look for notoriety and want to become infamous by making some sort of twisted statement about their unhappy life. Most of the killers are described as loners. Students with disorders such as bipolar disease or depression find it hard to see anything positive in their day to day lives. When they become hurt by events or activities that happen at school, such as being turned down for a date or being ridiculed by other members of their class, they tend to obsess over what they perceive as their own faults and shortcoming. Because these students find little hope in their existence, they may begin to dream of ending their own lives as well as the lives of those who have hurt them. It is typical of school violence to mainly affect those who are victimized by bullying classmates. The depression that breeds anger and hostility leading to violent tendencies in school bullies.

What is gun violence in schools?

School violence is a big threat that is increasing by passing days. Gun violence should be controlled in school so as to maintain peace. In almost every case, the shooters acted like they were on a suicide mission. What is needed now is increased awareness, both at home and at school. Some tightening of security is needed.
